In Part 3, some answers end before the ideas are fully developed. Repeated errors with verb forms and agreement also reduce accuracy. To move closer to Band 7, extend your explanations and check common grammar patterns.

Your three priorities

1	Extend your answers naturally Give a clear answer, then add a reason or example - especially in Part 3.
2	Make verb forms more accurate Check verb tense, subject-verb agreement and the pattern used after common verbs.
3	Use more precise topic vocabulary Replace general words such as 'good', 'bad' and 'things' with more exact language.

KEY IMPROVEMENTS EXPLAINED

1 Check tense and agreement

Use the present perfect for something that started in the past and is still true now. Remember that 'people' takes a plural verb.

2 Use 'there is' or 'there are'

To say that something exists, use 'there is/are', not 'there has/have'.

3 Use 'where' for places

Use 'where' when the next idea describes what happens in a place.

4 Choose '-ed' or '-ing' carefully

Things are 'amazing'; people are 'amazed' by them.

5 Add 'to' after 'cause + noun'

Say 'cause the culture to disappear', not 'cause the culture disappear'.

6 Develop Part 3 answers

Build each answer in four steps: opinion, reason, example and impact.

PART 1 I've lived there for five years. What I like most is the variety of independent restaurants near my home.

PART 3 Tourism can improve a city because it creates jobs; however, local authorities must protect the culture that attracts visitors.
